### 2022-2023 UNIFORM POLICY REMINDER

#### Dear Parents/Guardians,

The uniform policy is accessible on our school website on a continuous basis at [JaneSrobertsk8.net](http://JaneSrobertsk8.net).

Jane S. Roberts K-8 Center is a mandatory uniform school. Uniforms help students stay more focused and disciplined. In addition, students often feel less peer pressure when everyone dresses the same. The uniform code outlined here will be strictly enforced. Please review the information very carefully. There are several retail and/or uniform stores offering inexpensive uniforms. Please note that uniforms may be purchased at any retail store offering them. Listed below are the approved garments.

#### UNIFORMS FOR GRADES 6-8

Pants	Navy Blue color <b>BELTS ARE REQUIRED</b> <b>**Proper Fitting - no baggy/stretchy pants/joggers, or tight-fitting pants!</b> <b>PANTS MUST BE UNIFORM MATERIAL</b> ; straight or classic fit. <b>NOT</b> all stores offer uniform style pants.
Skirts/ Skorts	Navy Blue/ <b>MUST BE TO THE KNEES</b> <b>**MUST BE ABLE to identify navy color</b>
Polo Shirt	Khaki or Maroon Embroidered dark green for <b>Biomedical students only</b>
Undershirts	Any color – <b>MUST be TUCKED IN</b>
Emblem (Crest and/or Biomedical)	Can be Purchased from Ibiley or PTSA ( <a href="http://jsrk8ptsa.memberhub.com/store">jsrk8ptsa.memberhub.com/store</a> )
Sweatshirts/Sweaters	<u>Maroon, Red, or Navy Blue ONLY</u> / <b>NO LARGE LOGOS</b> Zip-ups are acceptable <b>NO HOODIES OR HOODED SWEATERS</b>
Shoes	Sneakers/ Closed-toe shoes are <b>REQUIRED</b>

- ***Belts MUST be worn properly-NO Spikes***
- ***Shirts (Polo and undershirt) MUST be tucked in***
- Jeans, sweatpants and shorts are **NOT PERMITTED** (unless notified of a special “jean day”)
- On designated jean days, jeans cannot have holes or be tight to the body. No legging style jeans.
- Skirts and Skorts length **MUST** be to the knee
- Polo shirts must fit properly, no **OVERSIZED** shirts
- No tops that expose midriff
- Caps are not permitted except during Physical Education (P.E.)
- No tight or baggy pants permitted (no jeggings, leggings, skinny pants, joggers)
- No Crocs or open-toes shoes
- Hair, jewelry, make-up, or any other items that the school determines are a distraction are not permitted

#### **Dress Code Violations**

Students who are found in violation of the dress code will receive the following consequences:

- **1<sup>st</sup> violation-** Verbal Warning
- **2<sup>nd</sup> violation-** Parent Contact
- **3<sup>rd</sup> violation-** Detention
- **4<sup>th</sup> violation-** Referral to Administrator/ SCSJ/ Parent Contact/SCM
